

BEST WORKSHOP AWARD

The SAEE Best Workshop Award recognizes arts entrepreneurship educators who develop dynamic workshops to share modules, exercises, lessons, and pedagogical ideas that can be utilized by other arts entrepreneurship educators. Finalists for this award will present their workshop at the annual SAEE conference where a panel of judges will collectively determine the award recipient.

Award Criteria:

- Quality of the workshop
- Effectiveness of the workshop
- Transferability of the workshop

Eligibility:

- Awards are granted to individuals, not organizations
- Conference Committee members of the SAEE Board are not eligible for award consideration (conference planning committee, awards chairperson)
- An individual is allowed to be a finalist in only one award category. In the event an individual is a finalist in multiple categories, the individual will need to choose one award category in which to compete

Process:

- Individuals must submit a proposal in the research track to present at the annual conference
- Submissions are blind reviewed
- Submissions will be peer reviewed to determine finalists
- Finalists are selected by scoring from proposals accepted to present at the conference
- Finalists will be notified via email of their finalist status and have the option to accept or reject the nomination
- Finalists are required to attend and present at the annual SAEE conference where a panel of judges will attend all finalist presentations and collectively determine the award recipient

Timeline:

- July 1, 2019
 - Submission deadline
- October 1, 2019
 - Award finalists announced via email and on the SAEE website
 - Finalists must acknowledge their status and plan to attend the annual conference
- October 17-19, 2019
 - SAEE annual conference at Iowa State University, Ames, IA.
 - Recipient of the award will be announced during the conference
